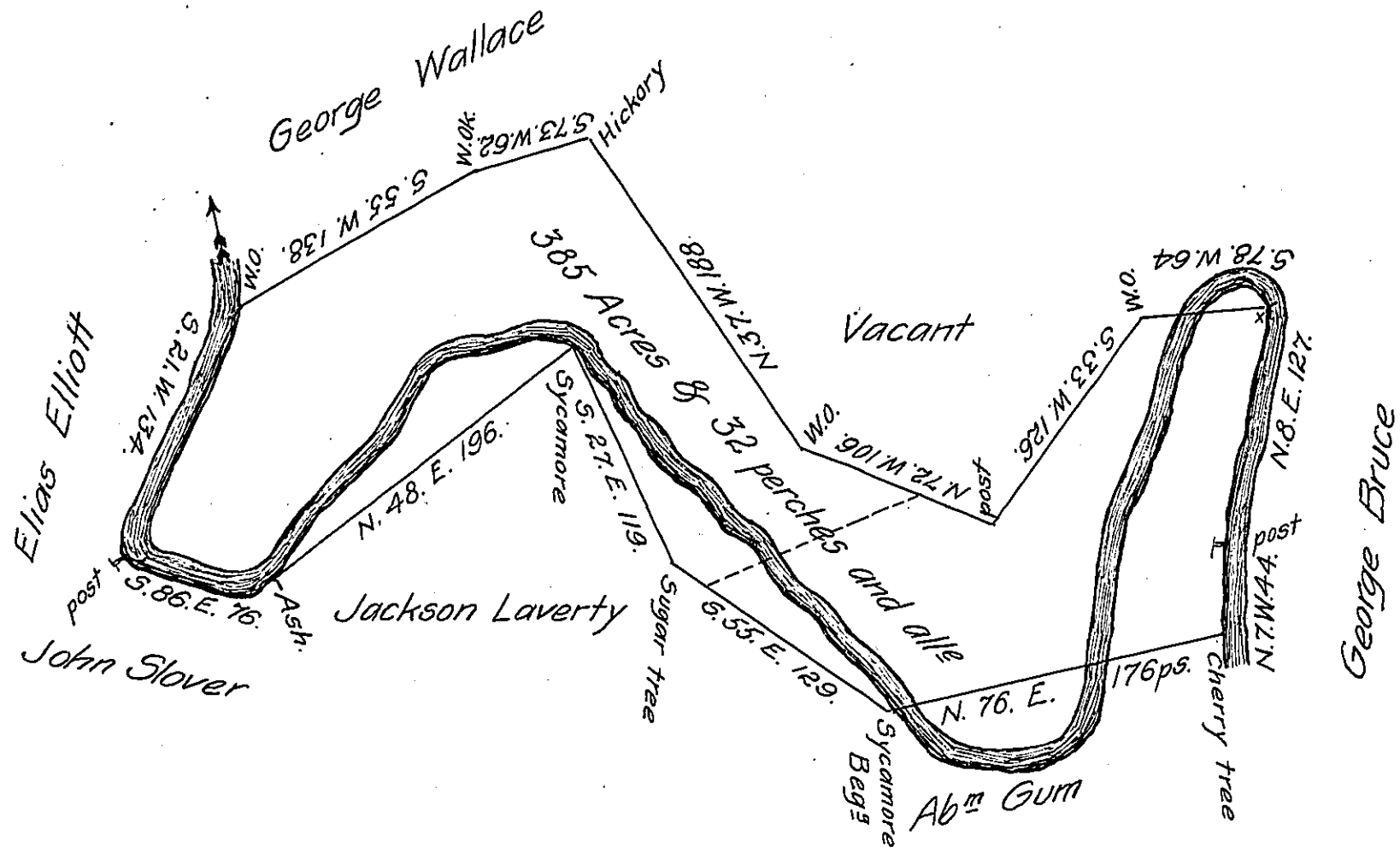

The above is a draft of a tract of land resurveyed Aug<sup>t</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> 1809 by order of the Board of property dated March 7<sup>th</sup> 1809 Granted in favor of Thomas Bracker's petition and in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Alexander Spiers, dated September 25<sup>th</sup> 1784, Situate in First Moon Township Beaver County, on Raccoon Creek, Containing 385 acres and 32 perches and Allowance of Six p<sup>t</sup> Cent &c. &c.
