



Situate on the ^{head} Waters of Lick, ^{run} in Turkeyfoot Township, Somerset County, Including an Improvement first begun the 1st day of May 1808. Whereon a family had resided and raised grain before the date of the Warrant & had Continued their residence there on until the time of the Survey - And Surveyed the 21st day of September 1816. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 22nd day of June 1812. Granted to James Skinner at 50/1⁰⁰ hundred acres - Yet it Blends with the tract John Skinner (of Samuel) in Settlement at patenting, this being like that, subject to 10/1⁰⁰ hundred acres & Interest from the 1st day of March 1779.
