Field Notes.

Beginning at a Stone Corner of Geo. Snyder's land in line of Stevenson & Snyder. Thence along same North 3°45' E 77 Per. to a Hem. Cor. of Robt Mahaffey's Land thence along same North 86°15' west. (Crossing Little Snyder Run at 63 per.) 107.5 per to Stone Corner of Henry Breth's land thence along same South 3°45' W. 77 Per. to Post by Hemk & R.or. Cor. of Henry Breth in line of Lewis Snyder's land thence along same South 86°15' E. (Crossing Little Snyder Run at 28 Per. Chest Cor. of Lands of Lewis & Geo. Snyder 48.6 P.) 107.5 Per. to Stone and place of beginning.
