



By virtue of an agreement of the inhabetance of Wrightstown bearing date ^{Seven hundred} the twenty third day of Desember in the year one thousand and nintzen surveyd this Lott of Land in Wrightstown square beginning ~~begi~~ at a Black oak being the Cornear of Joseph Chapmans Land then South West fifty Pearches to a marked hickory bey William Smith other Land then North West ninty five pearch to a Post by John Penquits Land then North East fifty pearches to an other post by a marked black oak saplin then South East ninty five Pearches by Josep^h Chapmans Land to the place of beginning containing Twenty Eight acres surveyd by me anno^d 1721
