



In pursuance of an order from the Secretary there was surveyed for William Speer a certain Lot of Ground situate in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland containing in Length East & West two Hundred and forty feet & in Breadth North & South sixty feet Bounded Northward by North Street, Eastward by Hannover Street, Southward by Lot No 155 & Westward by Lot No 128, Marked in the Plan of the said Town No 156.
