



Situate on the Branches of Clearfield Creek, about two miles below the old Ketanying Path, containing Four Hundred & Thirty three acres and one Hundred & fifty three Perches, & the usual allowance for Roads &c. Surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1793.
