



A Plan of a Lot of ground situate on the West side of Beaver Street in the Town of York containing in Breadth on said street fifty seven feet and six Inches and in Length to a twenty feet alley two hundred and fifty — feet Bounded Eastward with Beaver Street aforesaid Southward with a twenty feet alley Westward with a twenty feet alley and Northward with with a Lot of ground in the Tenure of Michael Leatherman and marked on the general Plan of the said Town Number Ninety nine entered on the Plan of the said Town and surveyed for Henry Schultz who has built an House thereon according to the Conditions of Settling the Town.
