



The above is a Draught of the resurvey of a Tract of three hundred and thirteen and an half acres of land & Allow<sup>±</sup> of Six P<sup>±</sup> Cent & C Situate on the West Branch of Fishing Creek said to be originally surveyed on an Order No 592 dated 3<sup>d</sup> of April 1769 and Resurveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> of April 1788 agreeable to the old lines, the said Order in the Name of John Sprugel and now claimed under him by Jacob Crawl and Henry Synger.
