The above Draught represents a Survey made September 28<sup>th</sup> AD 1824, in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Strouss dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of February AD 1824, Situated in Hopewell Township Beaver County containing Six acres and Eighty five perches and allowance of Six Per Cent &c. I Ross W<sup>o</sup> Law Deputy Surveyor Do certify that at the time of Survey that there was no Improvernt on the Ground that was made by Strouss or any person for him there was a man by the name of Lowery had an Improvement on the ground which he made a few days before I went to Execute the Warrant given under my hand
