



Situate on the dividing ridge between the head waters of Dunning's creek and those of Shawanese Cabin creek, in Napier township Bedford county, containing 158 acres 26 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. - Surveyed by James Allison Esq. for Benjamin Vore, the 27<sup>th</sup> of April 1852, being part of a tract that originally contained 336 3/4 acres and allowance Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Peter Shiras, dated the 7<sup>th</sup> of February 1765.
