



Situate in Lewis Township County of Lycoming on the East side of Lycoming Creek about 31 miles from its confluence with the West Branch of the Susquehanna and bounded as above described - Surveyed to Godfrey Sheffler on the Seventh day of December 1839 by virtue of his Warrant for 30th dated November the 16th 1839. Containing twenty Seven acres and one hundred & five perches with allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c.
