Conveyed part of the same to William Rule and Jane his wife who by their Deed dated 6<sup>th</sup> June 1809, Conveyed the same to Alexander M<sup>c</sup>Cutchen who by his last will and Testament in writing devised the said Forty three Acres and Fifty one perches and allowance to Elizabeth M<sup>c</sup>Cutchen now intermarried with Benjamin Blair Situate in Washington Township Westmoreland County Penna.
