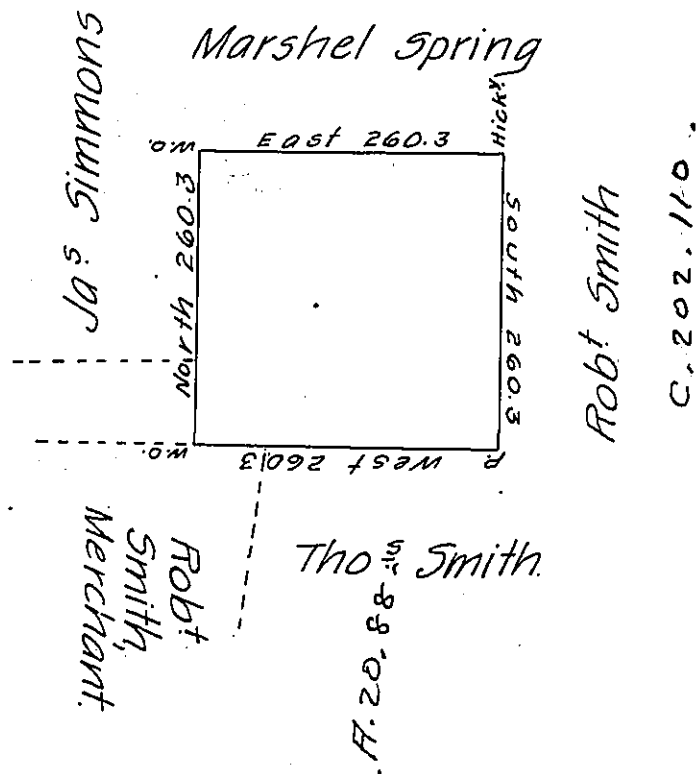

The above is the draught of a Survey made March 12<sup>th</sup> 1795, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Robert Smith, Hatter, on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1792. Situate Northwest of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek, adjoining land granted to Robert Smith, Merchant, called Fuligno, containing 400 Acres with the usual allowance of 6  $\frac{7}{8}$  Cent 8<sup>c</sup>
