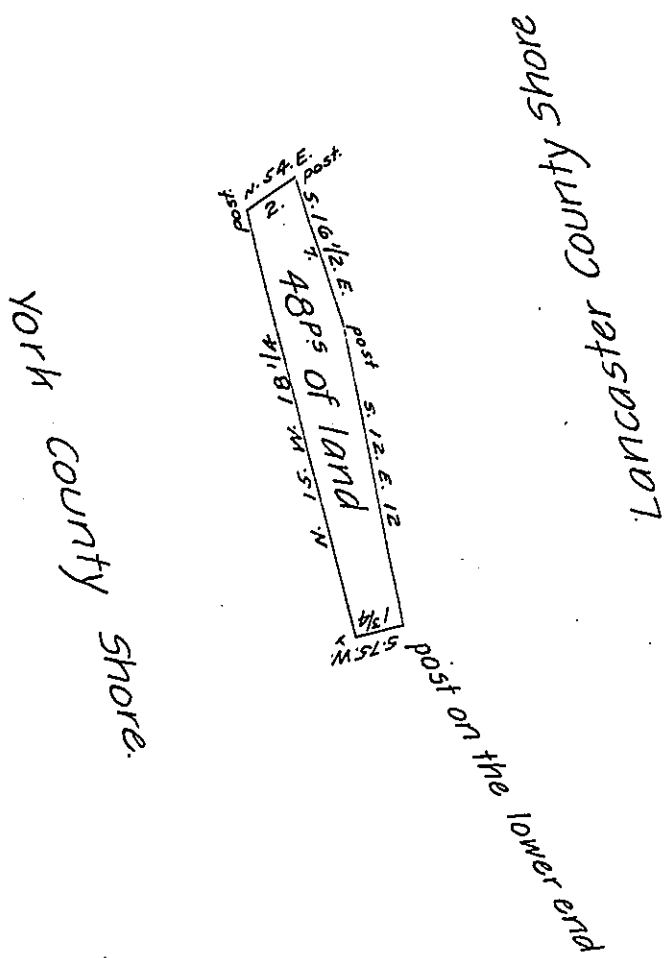

A Draught of an Island Situate in the river Susquehanna, Called Ceder Island, about thirty perches west of Williamsons Island and about forty perches from the Lancaster County Shore, in Little Britian Township in the County of Lancaster. Containing forty eight perches of land. Surveyed the 26th day of November 1803, by Henry Ream ^{then} Deputy Surveyor for Vincent Stubbs by Warrant dated the 7th of November 1803. taken from his field notes. Remaining in my office the 28th of March 1814.
