Situate in Hamilton Township, Franklin County (formerly Cumberland County) Containing Ninety one acres and One hundred and thirty eight perches and the usual Allowance of Six $\frac{7}{8}$ Cent for Roads $\frac{8}{8}$ Being part of a Tract of Two hundred and fifteen acres and one hundred and forty Seven perches & all.

Surveyed May 12th 1772 on an Order of Survey Granted Hugh Leany for 250^a Dated April 2nd 1767, N^o 3306. Resurveyed and laid off from the other part for the Heirs of Hugh Leaney, Jun., April 9th 1814.
