



By Warrant Dated the 24th Day of the Month called October Anno Dom. 1750. Surveyed on the 29th Day of the 8th Month 1751 unto Adam Wittman the above described Tract of Land Situate in Brecknock Township, in Lancaster County.

N. B. On the 11th Day of the second Month 1740, the Quantity of 127⁹ & allowance of the above Tract was surveyed to one Henry Stair in Right of John Stair. By Warrant Dated the 17th Day of the 3rd Month 1738, who sold to Christopher Wittman, who sold to Adam Wittman affs^d, who obtained the said Warrant in his own Name and included more land. The Draught of Stair is I believe in the office.
