



In pursuance of a Warr<sup>t</sup> dated 23<sup>d</sup> Feb<sup>y</sup> 1760, I have surveyed the 25<sup>th</sup> February 1760, unto Thomas Willing the above described Lot of Ground situate between the third & fourth Streets from Delaware & between Walnut Street & Spruce Street in the City of Philadelphia, containing in Breadth on the said Third & fourth Streets 150 feet & in Length 396 feet. Bounded Eastward by Third Street, afs<sup>d</sup> Southward by a sixty feet Lot of Ground granted Charles Stedman. Westward with Fourth Street afs<sup>d</sup> & Northward by a Messuage & Lot of Ground belonging to the said Thomas Willing.
