



A Draught of a Lot of Ground situate on the South side of Market Street in the Town of Carlisle and County of Cumberland, containing in Breadth East and West sixty Feet and in leng-North & South two hundred and forty feet, bounded Northward by the said Market Street, Westward by Lot Number one hundred and sixteen. Southward by a Twenty foot Alley, and Eastward by Lots Number one hundred and forty one, and one hundred and forty two belonging to the Honourable the Proprietaries which said Lot is marked in the Plan of the said Town N^o 124. Returned into the Surveyor General's Office the 28th day of ~~March~~ February Anno Dom. 1759.
