



In pursuance of a Warrant of Resurvey bearing date the 8th day of December 1787 unto William Wilson for resurveying a certain Tract of Land situate on a brach of Chilisquaque ^{Mahoning} Creek formerly Berk's now Northumberland County.

Surveyed by the late William Scull deceased for John Spencer on Application No 3845 bearing date the 5th day of September 1769. and resurveyed on the 13th day of December 1787 the above described Tract of Land containing Three hundred and one acres and three quarters and the usual allowance for Roads &c. for the said William Wilson
