



The above described tract of land containing 150<sup>67</sup>/<sub>2</sub> perches situate in Quemahoning Township Somerset County is part of a larger tract of 327<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> acres & allow<sup>e</sup> originally surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> of May 1770 in pursuance of an Application granted to Benjamin Hodgeland the 20 of April 1769 — No 3125 Divided off from said larger tract for the present owner.
