



Surveyed the above described tract of land the seventeenth day of January 1838 for George Shaffer by virtue of his Warrant for 150 acres dated 28th October 1837. Containing One hundred & sixty five acres with the allowance of six per cent for roads &c.

Situate in Washington Township Lycoming— including a part of a sink hole & bounded as above described

Note— The above land was surveyed to George Irwin in right of William Richardson in 1773 on Warrant dated 5. Aug. 1773 but appears to be abandoned by him. The dotted lines represent the remainder of said Survey
