



A Draught Two hundred and Sixty one acres & 5 perches of Land and allow of Six p Cent for roads &c. Situate in Arm-<sup>20</sup>ugh Township formerly Cumberland now Mifflin County. Being part of two tracts of Land the part marked A surveyed 19<sup>th</sup> June 1775 in pursuance of a Warrant to James Sterrett for 100 acres dated 1<sup>st</sup> day of July 1772 and appears to contain as above 65.69 perches and allowance &c. The part marked B containing 195.96 and the allow. &c. surveyed by Col John Armstrong in pursuance of a Warrant to James Sterrett dated the fourth day of Feb<sup>y</sup>. 1755. Resurveyed 29<sup>th</sup> May 1772 by W<sup>m</sup> Maclay D.S. agreeable to the Old lines. Resurveyed and divided the 13 & 14<sup>th</sup> of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1798 by W<sup>m</sup> Harris D.S. Resurveyed and Examined 29<sup>th</sup> June 1834 at the request of the present owner James Sterrett. By D Hough D.S.
