



Situated on the <sup>419 1/2</sup> Waters of Little Redstone Creek in Washington Township Fayette County and surveyed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of February 1786 in consequence of a Certificate from the Commissioners for settling and adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monongahela Youghio-geni & Ohio. Of which the following is a true copy.

We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims of Unpatented Land in the Counties of Monongalia, Yohogania and Ohio, do hereby Certify that Levi Stephens is entitled to Four hundred acres of Land in the County of Yohogania on the Waters of Little Redstone to include the Settlement made by William Bowling in the year of our Lord One thousand <sup>and</sup> seven hundred and Seventy four, also a Right in preemption to One Thousand acres adjoining thereto.

Given under our hands at Redstone old fort the Sixteenth day of December 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwe<sup>lth</sup>
