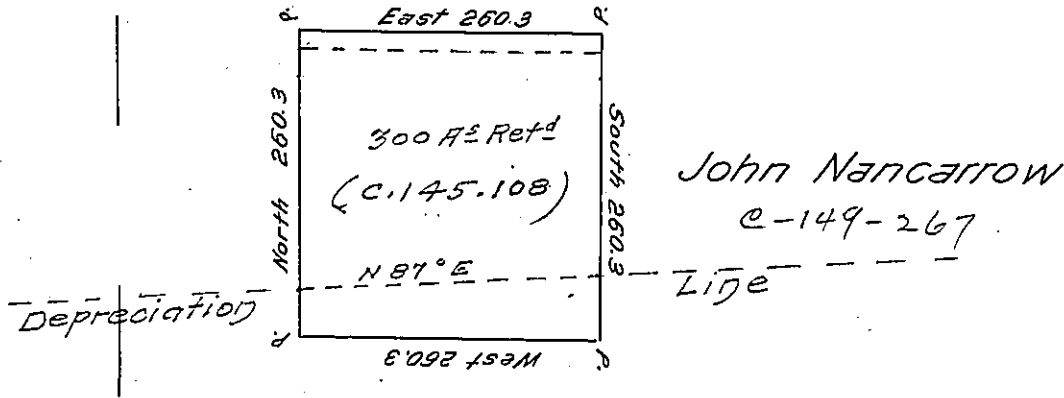

Nesbit — on the 14th day of April 1792 Situate North-west of the Ohio river on the Waters of Beaver Creek — — adjoining lands granted to John Nancarrow — called Buchorn — — containing four hundred Acres together with the usual allowance of 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent &c^a.
