



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle, in the County of Cum-
 berland marked in a general plan of said Town No. 169. Situate on the East^{side}
 of Hanover Street, and joining the South side of the Centre Square, containing
 in Breadth North and South on Hanover Street sixty feet, and in length
 East and West two hundred and forty feet. Bounded Westward with Hanover
 aforesaid. Northward part with the Centre Square, and part with Lot No.
 190. Eastward part with Lot No. 188, and part with ^{the end of a} twenty feet alley
 and Southward with Lot No. 168. Returned into the Secretarys Office
 the 26th day of May, 1792 for Robert Mc Graw Esq^r.
