



By virtue of a Warrant from the Comm^{rs} of Property to me directed bearing date the 19th /²⁷/₁₇₀₃ to lay out unto Joseph Paul 492 acres in right of Edward Bleuman his original purchase of 1000 acres; Surveyed and laid out unto the s^d Joseph Paul in the right afores^d a Tract of Land in Plumstead Township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post at Elizabeth Sands Corner, Thence North West four pole distant from Francis Plumsted's line three hundred and six perches and an half to a post, then by vacant land North East two hundred and fifty seven perches to a heap of stones near ^(ob) small Run, Then South East by vacant Land 306 1/2 perches to a Post at the s^d Eliz: Sands other Corner, then by the s^d Sands line South West 257 perches to the place of Beginning, Containeing four hundred ninety two acres & fifty perches, Laid out the 12th /⁴/₁₇₀₄
