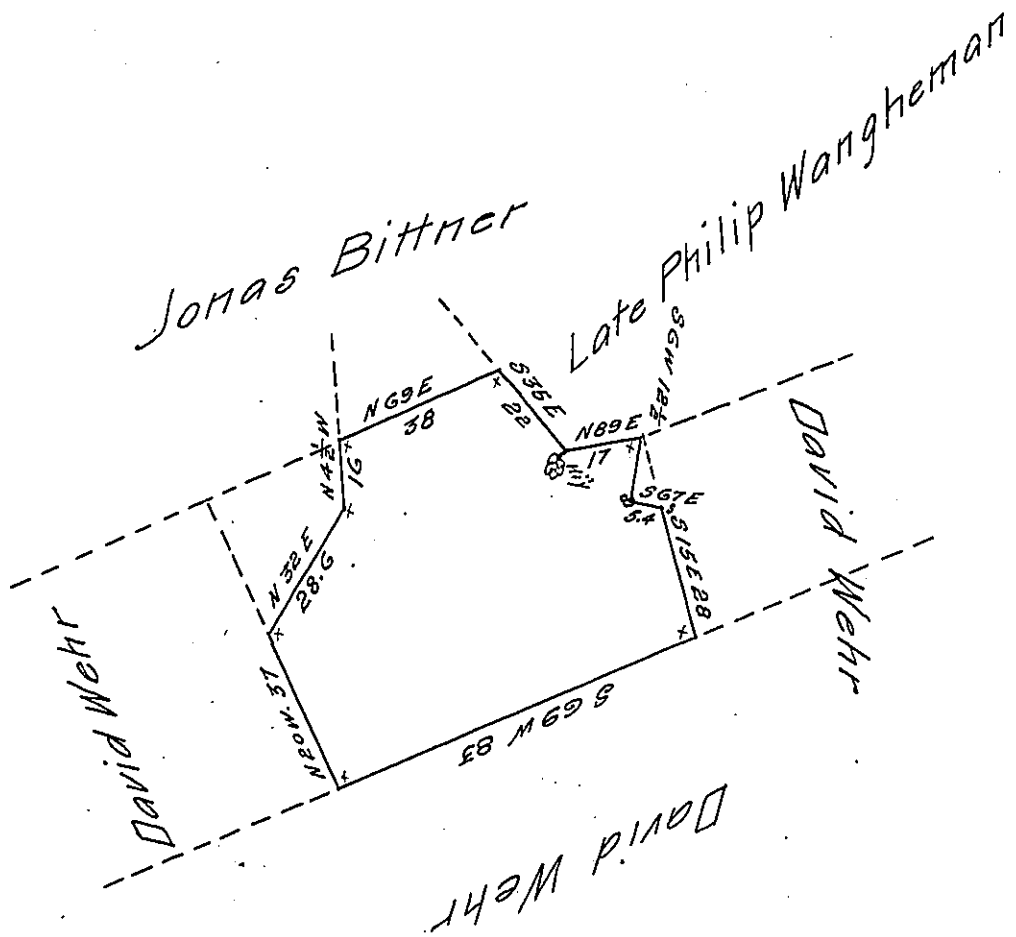


Lehigh County
