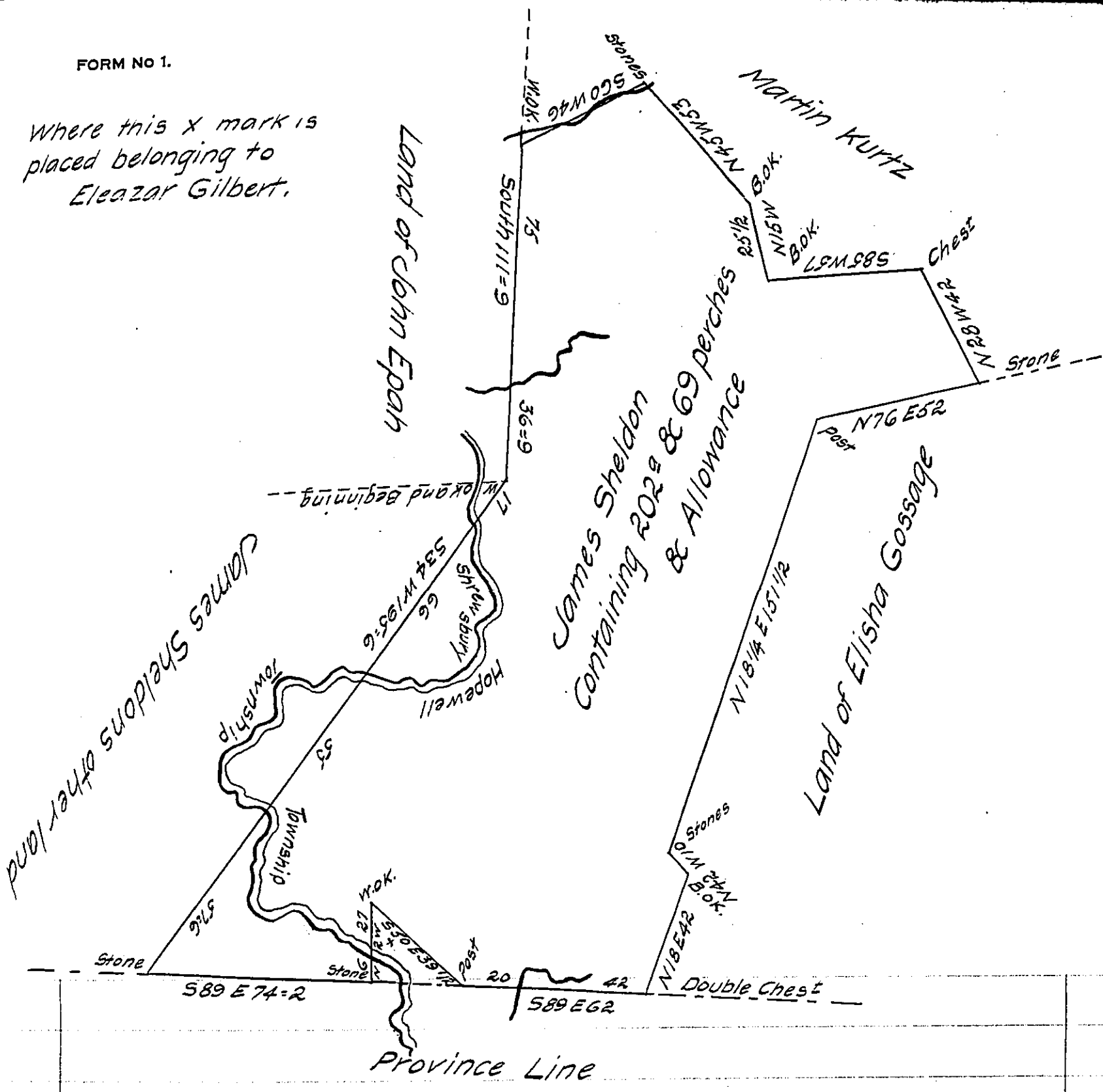


Where this X mark is placed belonging to Eleazar Gilbert.
