



Situate in Codorus Township York County, containing as above set forth one hundred and forty four acres, one hundred and twenty one perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November A.D. 1768 in pursuance of the application of Adam Michael N<sup>o</sup> 4340 dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September A.D. 1767. And now at the request of Henry Stambach, the Draught has been examined, corrected, Calculated, and returned for confirmation, as the Official Works of the said William Matthews February 13<sup>th</sup> 1822.
