



Situate in Managhan Township in the County of York containing as above set forth Sixty seven Acres, fifty five perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Being part of a larger tract of 283 acres 69 p^{rs} &c allowance originally Surveyed in pursuance of a Warrant for 250^{ac} granted to Henry Swancey dated the 29th day of December A.D. 1742. resurveyed by Jacob Spangler late D.S. on the 25th day of March 1814. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 11th day of April A.D. 1818 and now at the request of John Fickis the present owner of said part, the Draught is examined corrected and returned for confirmation January 19th 1822.
