



Situate in Windsor Township York County, contain within the black lines as above set forth, thirty three Acres eighty six perches and allowance of six per cent for roads & a Being part of the same land which was surveyed by William Kersey late D.S. on the 28th of the 5th month 1794 in pursuance of a Warrant for three pieces granted to John Schmuck, dated the 4th day of December 1793- The above part resurveyed and divided off the said larger tract for the present owner William Wayne, on the 18th day of September 1821, and at the request of the said Wayne, the same is returned for confirmation.
