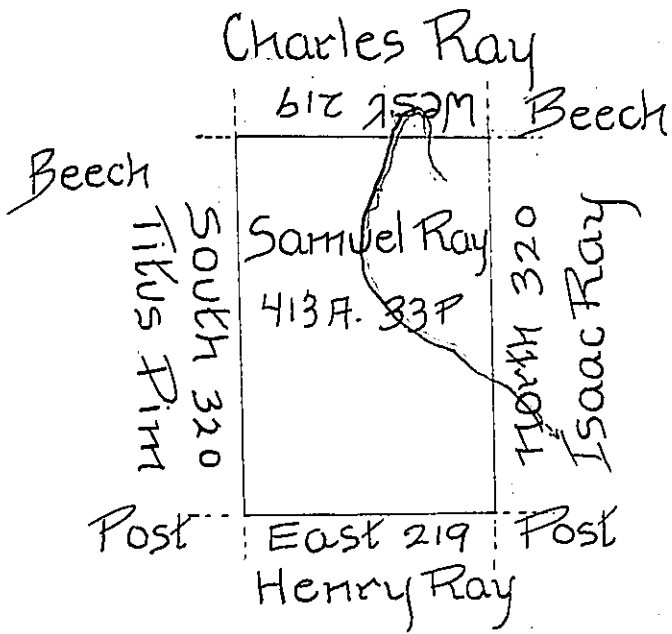


The names of Ray should be Rea
