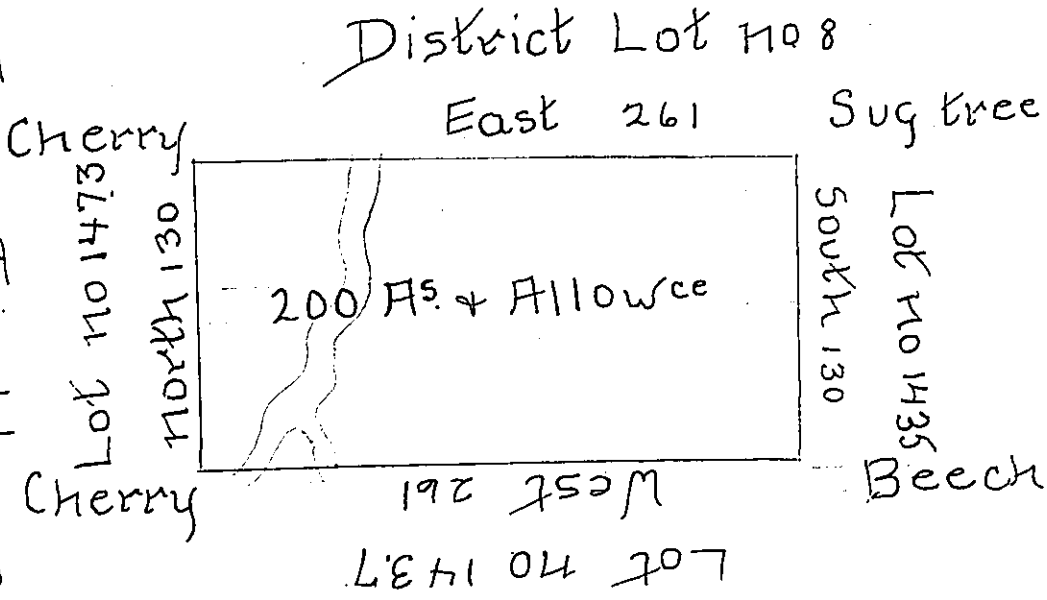


Recd of James Trimble a patent for this tract of Land in right of Thomas Barlow private dated June 22nd 1797

In pursuance of an act of Genl Assembly of the state of Pennsylvan^{ia} passed the 24th day of February 1785. Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth + by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbat^{on} of the Honl the Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 18th day of Augt 1785 the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres + Allow of 6 p cent for roads + n^o MCCCCXXXVI situate in Dist n^o 7 on the west side of the Allegh^y River in the County of Westmorland
