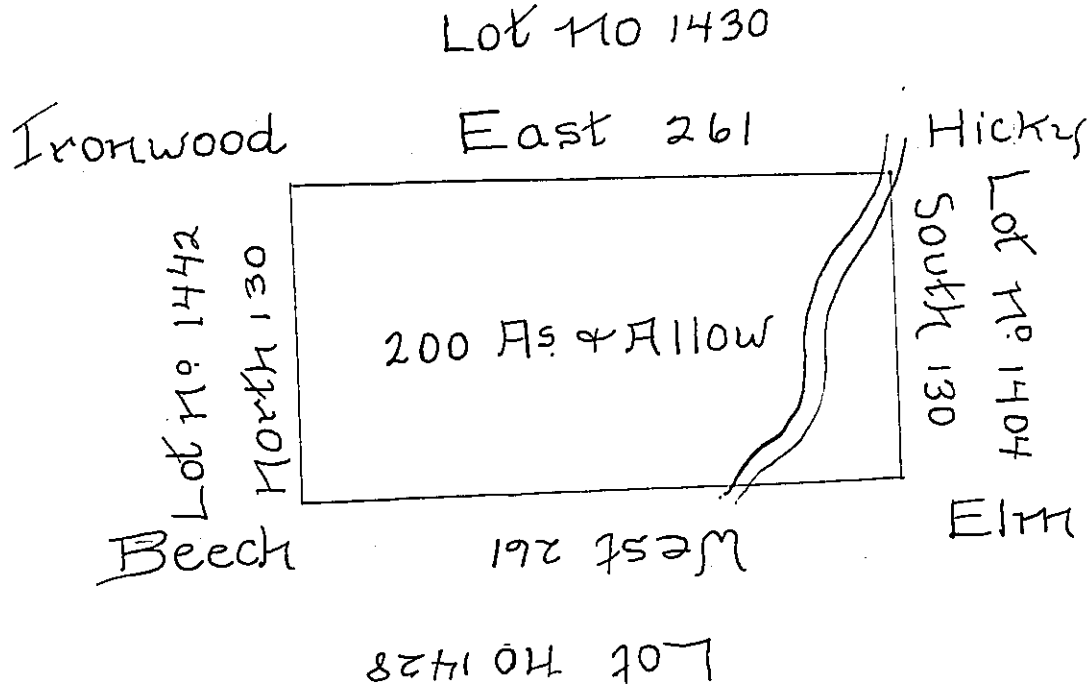

Intitled an act for Directing the mode of Distributing the Donation Lands Promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the Surveyor Genl with the Approbation of the Honl the Executive Council I have Surveyed on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of Augt 1785. Intitled as the above Described tract of two Hundred Acres & Allow of 6 p cent for roads & no Mccc-~~CXXVIII~~<sup>IX</sup> situate In Dist No 7 on the west side of the Allegy river in the County of Westmorland To John Lukens Esqr Willm Power D.S
