



In pursuance of an act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for Directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth; and by order of the Surveyor General with the Approbation of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785, the above described Tract of two hundred acres of land and allowance of six per cent. for roads &c No 1618 situate in District No 8 on the West side of the Alleghany river in the county of Westmorland.
