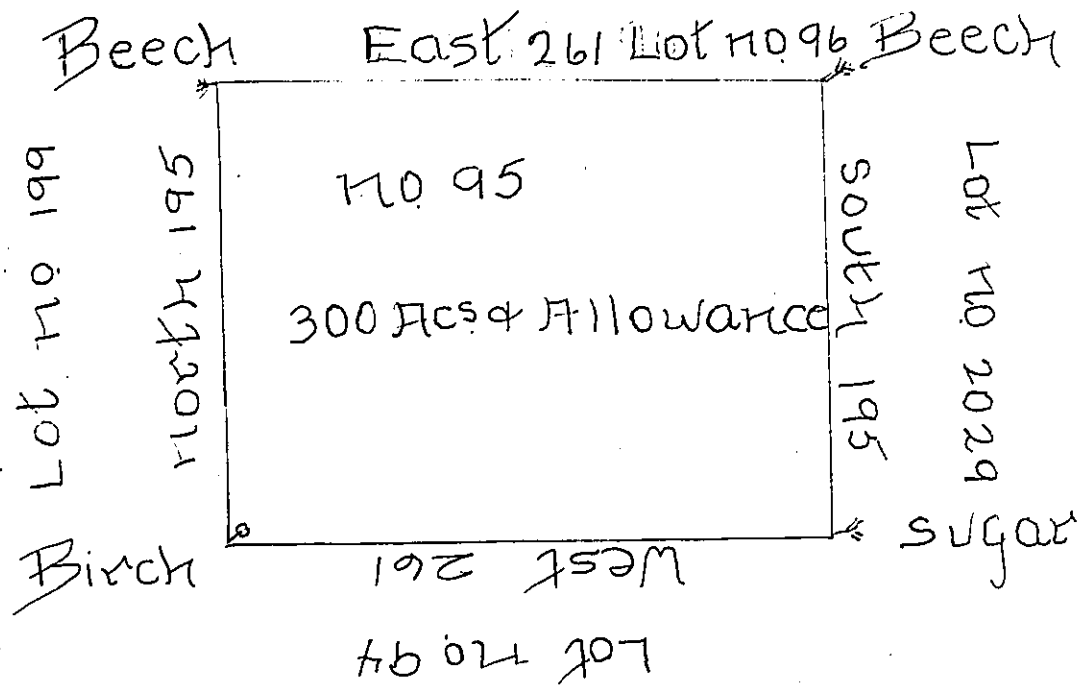

In pursuance of an act of General Assembly
 of the state of Pennsylvania passed the 24th
 day of February 1785 ~~the above described~~

 mode of distributing the donation lands
 promised to the troops of this Commonwealth"
 And by order of the Surveyor General
 with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} Executive
 Council, I have surveyed on the 11th day of
 August 1785 the above described tract of three
 hundred Acres and Allowance of six per
 cent for roads &c no. xcvi situate in district no. 10 on
 the west side of Alleghany river in the County of Westmoreland.
