



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this Commonwealth; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honorable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1785, The above described Tract of five hundred acres of land, and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c. No 151 situate in District No 8 on the west side of the Allegheny river, in the county of Westmoreland.
