

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of
Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February, 1785, entitled
"An Act for directing the mode of distributing the donation lands
promised the Troops of this common wealth; and by order of the
Surveyor General with the approbation of the Honourable the
Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the 26th day
of October, 1785, the above described Tract of Five Hundred
acres of Land, and allowance of six per cent. for roads, &c.

Allegany river, in the county of Westmoreland.
