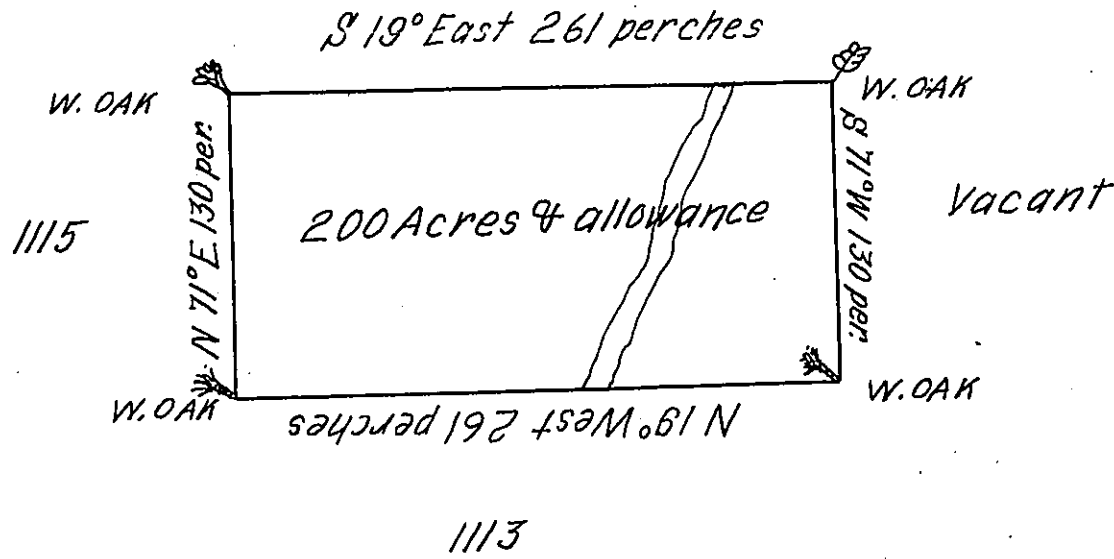

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Pennsylvania, passed the twenty-fourth day of February 1785 entitled, "An Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the Troops by this Commonwealth" and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation of the Hon^{ble} the Executive Council, I have surveyed on the thirteenth Day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land and Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads & N^o 1114: situate in District N^o 6 on the West Side of the Allegheny River in the County of Westmoreland.
