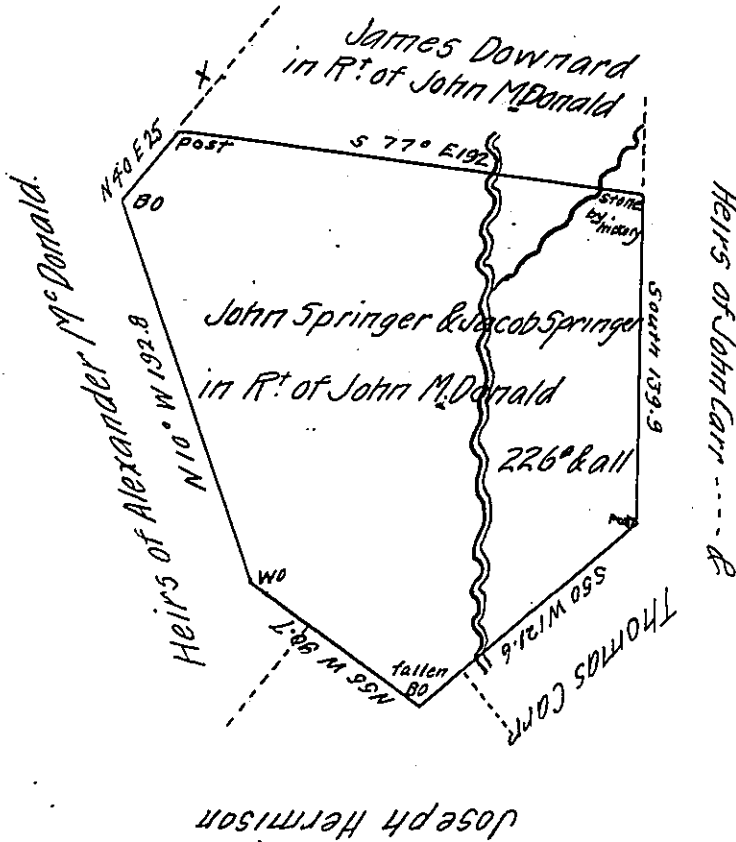

The above is part of a tract of land (now situate on York's Run in George Township Fayette County) which ^{was} surveyed to John McDonald 30th October 1769 by order of Survey N^o 3073 dated the 7th day of April 1769 - the whole of which tract he, by his last Will & Testament dated 12th April 1786 did give and bequeath unto his Wife - viz "Mary" and his Daughter "Rachel" who intermarried with the above named James Downard the present owner of the residue - the parties have agreed on a Division as stated - and the lines I ran 1st & 2nd November 1796. Mary has released to her son David, and David has Devised the same to his Nephews John & Jacob Springer before named - the parties are desirous of obtaining Separate Patents. I have conformed the Variation to the Original and Corrected Errors found
