



A Draught of a Tract of Land Surveyed the 8<sup>th</sup> day of January 1802 for Frederick Sellers by Virtue of his Warrant for one hundred and fifty acres of Land Dated the 26<sup>th</sup> day of January 1785 Situate in East Bethlehem Township Washington County including an improvement on a branch of ten Mile Creek called Plumb run containing one hundred and fifty acres together with the usual allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads.
