



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 19<sup>th</sup> 1794 in  
 pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Adamson Tannehill for 400 Acres  
 of Land Dated the tenth day of February 1794 Adjoining John Mc Masters to  
 the Eastward and on the South Side of the Conaquesing Creek including  
 a part of said Creek North and West of the River Ohio Alleghany and  
 Conawango Creek Called Stanton Containing four hundred and thirty  
 Six Acres three quarters and Twenty five poles together with the Usual  
 Allowance of Six p<sup>t</sup> Cent for R<sup>d</sup>.
