



In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the State of Penn-  
 sylvania, passed the 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 1785, entitled "An Act for directing  
 the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised the Troops of this  
 Common wealth"; and by order of the Surveyor General with the approbation  
 of the Honourable the Supreme Executive Council, I have surveyed on the  
 2<sup>nd</sup> day of November 1785, the above described Tract of Two hundred acres of land  
 and allowance of six percent for roads &c.

 in the county of Westmoreland.
