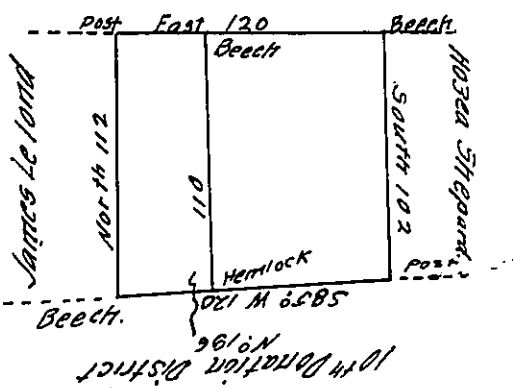


Pennsylvania Population Company
