



A draught of a part of a tract of land which was surveyed in pursuance of a special order granted to Arthur St. Clair Esq on the 18th day of November 1776 by George Woods the then Deputy Surveyor containing one hundred and twenty four acres one hundred and thirty eight perches and the allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c. Situate adjoining the Village of Ligonier and bounded one side by the Greensburg and Stoystown Turnpike road in Ligonier township in the County of Westmoreland. Surveyed April 6th 1830.
