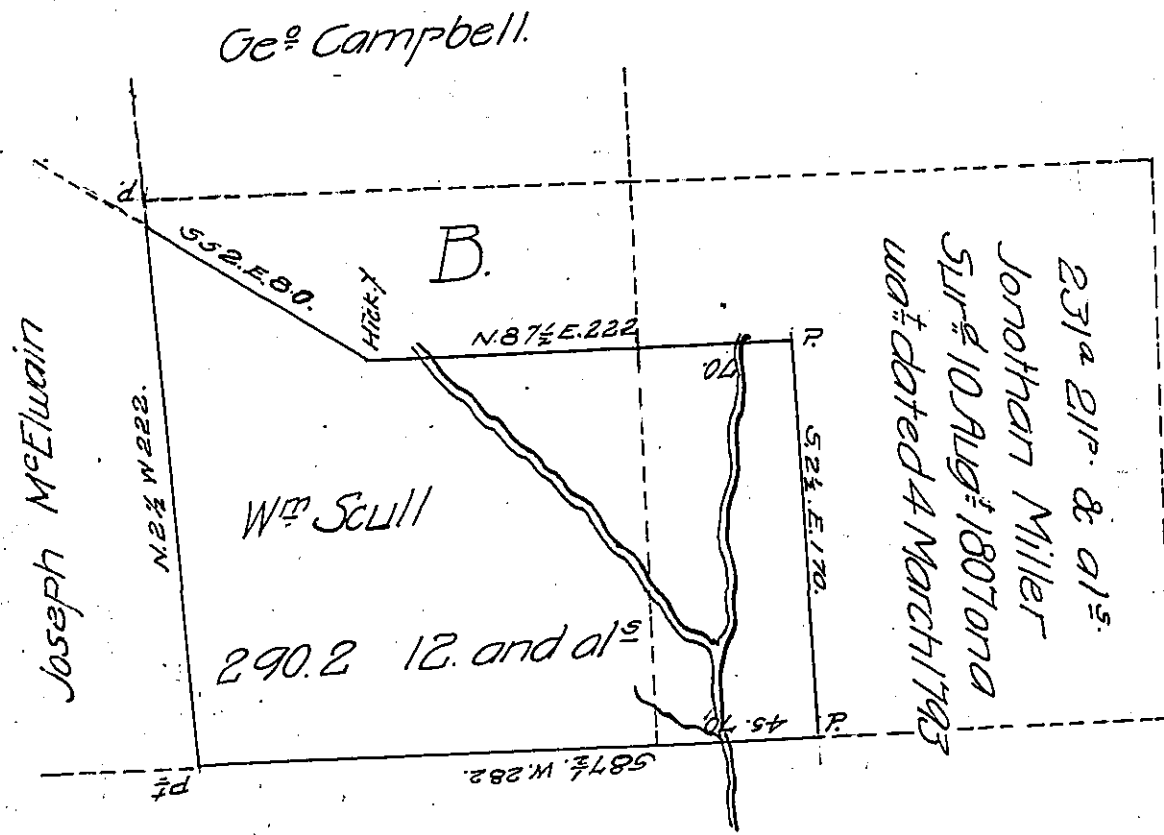

A Draught of a survey executed April 22<sup>d</sup> 1830 on a warrant in the name of William Scull dated 4<sup>th</sup> March 1793 Situate in district N<sup>o</sup> 8 N.W. of the Allegheny River Deer Township Allegheny County. Containing two hundred ninety acres two roods twelve perches and allow<sup>s</sup> of Six pct. for roads &c

Note. There is an interference with a survey in the name of Jonathan Miller (shown by the dotted line) of sixty nine acres three Roods thirty perches & al<sup>s</sup>. Note 2<sup>d</sup> By an order of the Board of Property dated June 21<sup>st</sup> 1799. a resurvey was made July 25 1799 and ~~a~~ excluded a part of what might have been designed to fill the survey Originally, not interfering with Geo Campbell-marked B.
