



The above is a Draught of a Survey, made April 29<sup>th</sup> 1828. in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Alexander Scott, for two hundred Acres, of Land, but Contains one hundred and ninety three Acres, and 8 1/2 perches, and Allowance of six per Cent for highways, situate in Cross Creek Township, W.C. on the waters of Cross Creek, Warrant Dated Feb. 18th 1828. — The owner is now residing on the Land, and it appears to have been improved for 29 or 30 years.
