



The above is a Draught of a Survey Made the 30<sup>th</sup> of January 1795. in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Francis Swane for 400 Acres of Land Dated the 4<sup>th</sup> of January 1794. Situate North and West of the River Ohio on Slippery Rock Creek --- adjoining Land Granted to Peter Muhlenberg --- Called Newbury Containing four Hundred <sup>one</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Acres and allowance of Six <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> Cent for Roads.
