



Situate on the North West side of Tussey's mountain, in Southampton Township Bedford county containing 390 acres 123 perches and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Surveyed the 3<sup>rd</sup> of August 1852 by Patrick Donahoe Esq. in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Daniel Jewell for 400 acres dated the 24<sup>th</sup> of July 1852. Courses according to the magnetic and not the true bearings.
