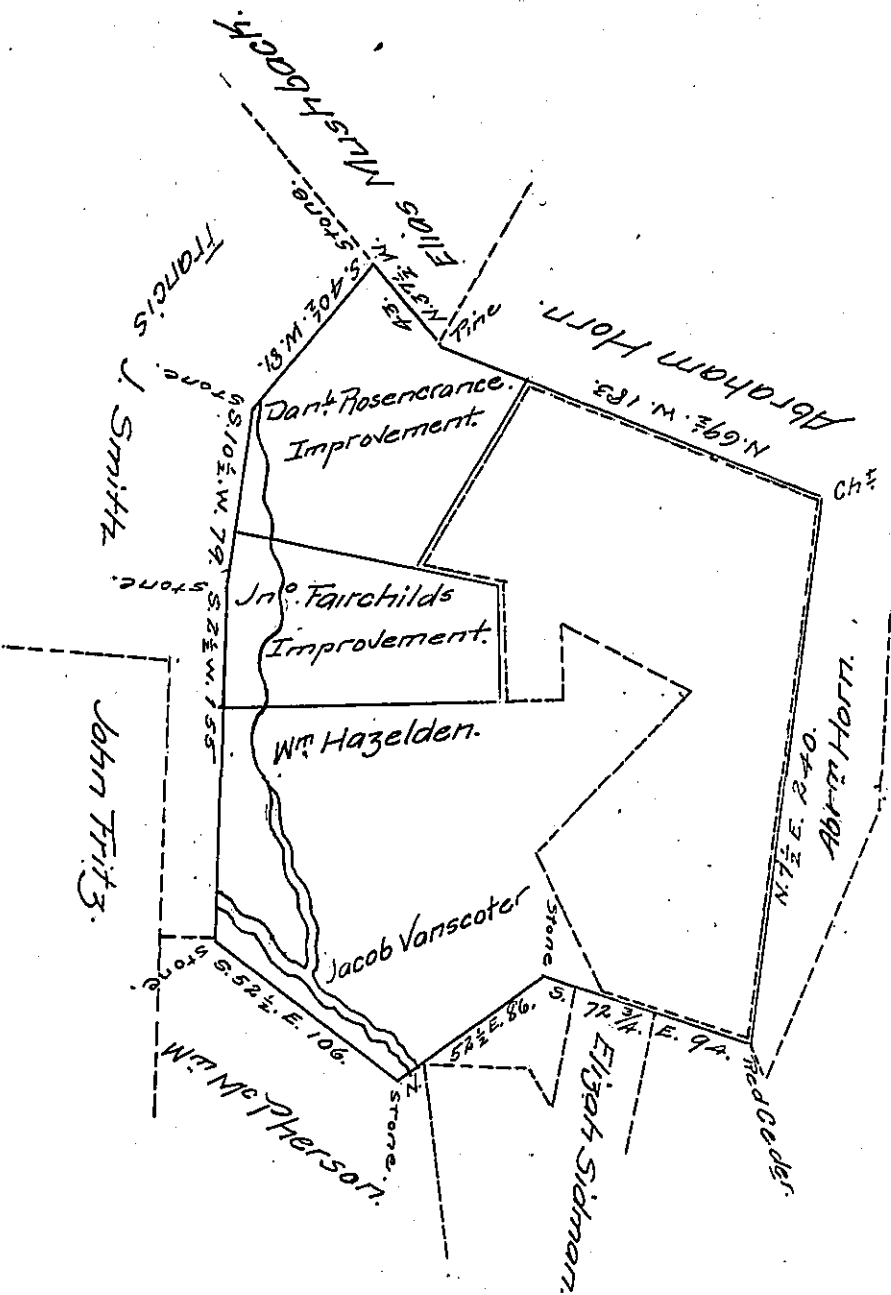


Del. - PIKE. ✓



By virtue of a Warrant dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October 1788 and an Order of Survey received December 21<sup>st</sup> 1853. Surveyed the 7<sup>th</sup> day of April 1855. to John Taggart the above described Tract of Land Situate in Delaware Township (Formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining lands surveyed to Eliza Sidman Abraham Horn, Elias Mushback, Francis J. Smith and William McPherson Containing Four hundred and Seven Acres and one hundred and Fifty Six perches and the allowance of Six per cent for Roads &c.
